PRIVATE WATER SYSTEMS

Many on-site wells servicing a home or small business on the Eastern Shore of Maryland are drilled into the Aquia Aquifer. This aquifer has been associated with salt water intrusion and high levels of arsenic. The Aquia Aquifer is also associated with seasonal fluctuations in water table which result in well failures. Buyer is advised to contact a qualified inspector to investigate for potential salt water intrusion, bacteria, arsenic and other water quality factors.

SEPTIC SYSTEMS

Buyers are hereby advised to have the septic system inspected by a qualified professional before completing any purchase transaction. Furthermore, while a qualified professional can provide a report on the current operating condition of the septic system, it is not a guarantee of future operation.

EXTENSION OF PUBLIC SEWER AND WATER

Public sewer and/or water service may be extended to the community in which you intent to purchase property. The extension of this service could result in substantial fees assessed to current and/or future property owners. Buyer is advised to contact the Department of Public Works for Caroline County to determine if any the property is currently being assessed or evaluated for additional assessments.
